It can also be booked for private functions, including:

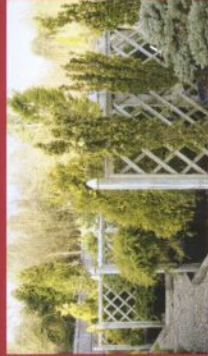

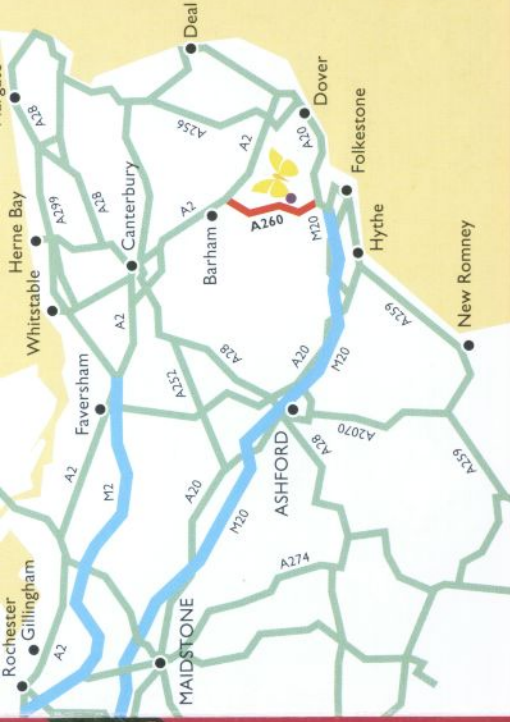
SHOP FOR THE GARDEN...

Where can you see the world's largest moth? Or discover a butterfly with the 'feathers' and 'eyes' of an owl? And where will you find a butterfly with wings so delicate you can see through them? Surprisingly, in a quiet corner of Kent, and it's the only place of its kind for miles around.



Watch the kids' eyes light up as they stroll in a tropical 'rainforest' setting at MacFarlane's World of Butterflies. Here you'll discover

swallow tails, fritillaries, dainty heliconids, impressive owl butterflies and the giant Atlas moth as they flutter freely among bougainvillea, hibiscus, oleander, lantana and gigantic fruiting banana plants, feeding on the nectar.

Marvel at these beautiful and exotic insects from around the world - up to 150 at any one time. Learn about their amazing life cycle - from egg to caterpillar to chrysalis - and finally to butterfly (or moth)!
